- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.

- Comply with training, competition, curfew, and behaviour requirements directed by New Zealand Canoe Polo while in camp and on tour.
- Do not engage in sexual behaviour while in camp or on tour.
- Do not possess or consume prohibited substances while in camp and on tour.
- Do not consume or purchase alcohol and tobacco while in camp or on tour without the agreement of the manager and coach.
- Be a positive role model.
- Have respect for New Zealand Canoe Polo property and the property of others.
- Never act in a way that may bring disrepute or disgrace to New Zealand Canoe Polo, its members, stakeholders, and sponsors/potential sponsors.
