We are now seeking applications from U21 Women for the 2020 World Championships.

Emma Hicks and Luke Anderson are the appointed Co-coaches and Co-managers.

Background

Camps will be held in Palmerston North.

- 1st Camp September 28-29
- 2nd Camp Jan 5-7 (3-day camp)
- 3rd Camp March - Selections at this camp or at first National League.
- 4th Camp May
- 5th Camp June
- 6th Camp July

The U21 Paddle Ferns will also play the 2020 National League Open B-grade.

Note players may be dropped at any time if the coaches feel they do not meet the required standard.

Travelling players will need to be a minimum of 16 years of age on the 1st Jan 2020.

Applications are open for players younger than this on the understanding they will not be selected to the travelling team.

The primary method of communication will be via a Facebook closed group; Paddle Ferns 2020 World Championships.

Tour Costs and Payment

Tour costs will be firmed up as we finalise the shape of the tour, early estimate would suggest a cost in the region of \$8-10,000.

Training camp fees are a set fee of \$250 per player per camp for a 2-day camp. Cost of longer camps to be confirmed prior to the camp. All camp surpluses (if any) will be retained for the selected team.
