We are now seeking applications from Senior Women for the 2020 World Championships.

Background

We are looking to kick off our Senior Women campaign with the first camp on the 28th/29th Sept in Palmerston North.

All Squad members will be expected to play in NL A Grade Women's with their own teams.

Selected Players will also be playing in NL B Grade Open with the NZ Squad.

Provisional dates for camps:

- Camp 1 – 28/29 Sep - Palmy (With the U21 Girls)
- Camp 2 – 2/3 Nov - Otaki
- Camp 3 – 8/9 Feb - Otaki (This could change to January 5th -7th combined camp with the U21 women)
- NL A and B Grade 1 – March - TEAM SELECTION
- NL A and B Grade 2 – April
- Camp 4 – April - Otaki (Date TBC)
- NL A and B Grade 3 – May
- Camp 5 – June - Palmy (potentially with the U21 women)
- Camp 6 – July - Palmy (potentially with the U21 women)

- At this stage we are looking at a 3-4-week tour in Europe.

Tour Costs and Payment

Tour costs will be firmed up as we finalise the shape of the tour, early estimate would suggest a cost in the region of \$8-10,000.

Fees will be a fixed cost per player per camp of \$250. All camp surplus will be retained and applied to the selected team. NZCPA is able to provide quotes for any players/ clubs or regions who wish to apply for funding.

Special Notes for this campaign.

Player applicants are able to withdraw from the Senior Squad up until the Friday after the first camp (claims deadline) and be eligible to receive a refund of their \$100 squad fee.

Phil Hart has been appointed as a Co-coach for the 2020 campaign, and we have put out a call for applicants for a suitable person to Co-coach alongside him. Should we not receive a suitable applicant this will be up for review.
