- Health and safety, Safeguarding Children guidelines are fit for purpose. Work with the Squads, high Performance and Competition councils as required.
- Ensure New Zealand has a strong voice at ICF referee discussions. Appoint a liaison with ICF referee and rules decision making body/s
- Ensure communication and interpretation is consistent. Ensure NZCPA liaise with ICF referee council to ensure we are consistent with the direction they are pursuing.
- Administration of qualified referees and the qualification process.
- Course providers: identify who they are and codify how we charge fees and run courses.

Person Specification

- Able to delegate key tasks to a wide variety of volunteers.
- Excellent communication with a wide variety of volunteers and stakeholders
- While its would be ideal for the applicant to be a qualified referee, this is not imperative as you are able to co-opt suitable members/ advisors to the referee council.
